SCHOOL REGULATIONS- DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION CHAPTER 19

Regulations and school guidelines are implemented during the summer school session. Discipline guidelines and consequences are as follows:

1. The summer school director may impose disciplinary action as needed.
2. Prohibited student conduct and penalties.
The following prohibited conduct applies to all students during the summer session hours on school premises or during department supervised activities.

CLASS A OFFENSES- UNLAWFUL CONDUCT:

Assault, burglary, dangerous weapons, firearms or instruments, possession or use of drug paraphernalia, extortion, murder, property damage, robbery, terroristic threatening or sexual offenses.

CLASS B OFFENSES

Pertain to disorderly conduct, insubordination, disregarding classroom rules, smoking.

DRESS CODE: Clothing must be appropriate to school. Wearing clothing related to drugs, gangs, profanity, or that is indiscreet is not allowed. Short shorts and short skirts above the finger tips, see-through clothing, strapless and backless attire, halter tops, spaghetti straps, tops that expose the midriff and cleavage are NOT permitted. Tank tops must not have large cut armholes and undergarments should not be showing.

ANY STUDENT WHO COMMITS A CLASS A OR CLASS B OFFENSE SHALL BE DISMISSED FROM THE SUMMER ENRICHMENT PROGRAM WITH NO REFUND.

PARENT/GUARDIAN STATEMENT OF UNDERSTANDING: I have read the rules and policies of King Intermediate Summer Enrichment Program with my child and agree to support them.
